# CPAP Cleaning Instructions



# **Daily**

- Wash mask with soapy warm water in the morning to remove facial oils that have accumulated.
- 2. Rinse well.
- **3.** Allow to air dry.

Do not use alcohol products on the mask because it will harden the mask cushion.

#### **Humidifier:**

- 1. Fill chamber just before use with distilled water.
- **2.** Pour out remaining water from the humidifier after each use and clean with soap and water. Rinse and air dry.
- **3.** Some chambers are dishwasher safe (top rack only). Refer to the user's manual.

# Weekly

## **Tubing, Mask, Headgear and Water Chamber:**

- **1.** Disconnect the tubing from the unit and the mask.
- **2.** Wash tubing, mask, headgear and water chamber in a mild soap.
- 3. Rinse well.
- **4.** Allow to air dry (if not dry when you are ready to use, put the system together and run for 30 minutes).

#### **Unit:**

Wipe off the outside of the machine with a soft damp cloth and mild cleaner.

#### **Headstrap:**

- 1. Wash by hand with soap or laundry detergent.
- 2. Rinse well.
- **3.** Hang to dry. Machine drying will cause shrinkage.

### Monthly

Filter: Replace white filter.

#### Six Months to One Year

**Mask, Tubing and Water Chamber:** It is recommended all be replaced every six months, but no longer than a year.
